At a time when most pro-life work is winding down for the summer months, the CLC Toronto offices are abuzz with much activity.

Since attacks on human life don't take a holiday, our efforts to stop abortion, prevent euthanasia and defend life at all its stages, continue full speed ahead.

As has been our custom for over 20 years, we have hired pro-life students to help us during June, July and August to get the work completed on time.

These students, mainly from university and college, have a hands-on opportunity to participate in life and family activities and strategies while they complete data entry and other day-to-day tasks, usually done by regular staff.

At weekly training sessions, the students hear presentations by a variety of pro-life leaders, view video reports by T.V. news networks on news conferences, marches, rallies and other interesting events related to CLC and pro-life and family activities.

Although we receive a small subsidy for these students, it's a long way from paying them their total salaries.

So we need your financial assistance to help us provide the weekly compensation.

The future of the movement is now. Please help us to train and provide the front-line troops for the next several generations of full time workers.

Many of our supporters believe that our society is in a total meltdown, as it struggles under the weight of abortion-on-demand, proposed changes to the definition of marriage and the push by Justice Minister Irwin Cotler to open the euthanasia debate.

On a recent visit home by a Canadian missionary stationed in Latin America, he asked relatives how they could stand the sexually explicit TV ads, openly suggestive TV programs and blatant attacks on people of faith.

Actually, many of our senior supporters are appalled that their country has taken this path in the last few decades and are fearful of what is to come: forced abortion, forced sterilization, euthanasia, assisted suicide, marrying one's siblings, children and animals, incest and much more.

Phew!


All of this is possible, but all or most of it is preventable.
