
Instead of being an obvious voice, studies show that there is a HUGE lack of young voters when

- 4. Do you think abortion is a settled issue or do you think it is something that needs to be addressed once again in parliament?

By using this information, you can not only make an informed decision about who you want to represent you in parliament, but you can also submit your findings to Campaign Life Coalition. CLC can then post relevant information on-line and help thousands of Canadians make informed and intelligent decisions about their political candidates.

2010 March For Life ABORTION - A CRIME AG INST HUM NITY

On May 13th, 2010, a crowd of over 12,500 people came together in Canada's capital to protest against the injustice of abortion. As seems to be the growing trend, the majority of those attending the National March for Life were young people. From noon till almost 5:00 p.m. Parliament Hill was filled with pro-lifers listening to talks given by the president of CLC, Jim Hughes, politicians, religious

leaders and spokespersons from Silent No More.

Taking place alongside the annual banquet on the night of the March, was the Youth Rose Dinner, accommodating the ever-growing number of young people getting involved in the pro-life

movement. Melissa Ohden, an abortion survivor and compelling pro-life activist, was the evening's keynote speaker. Her story revealed the grotesque reality of abortion; but as a hopeful survivor, her inspirational talk focused on the value and dignity of human life.

Stephanie Gray, co-founder and executive director of the Canadian center for Bio-Ethical Reform spoke next, and delved into the horrible truth of abortion, emphasizing the importance of life regardless of the stage of development or the disabilities a baby may have. The powerful video of Nick Vujicic, a man without arms and legs, served to bolster her point and provided audiences with a

passionate story of survival and human worth.

Scattered throughout the day were workshops by Melissa Ohden, John-Henry Westen, Alex Schadenberg and David McDonald. Topics included euthanasia and assisted suicide, activism, and the



News on the University Front:

Fighting the Good Fight

Interesting fact number one: the word "Google" can be used as both a noun and a verb.

Interesting fact number two: If you "Google" University of Calgary Pro-Life Group, you literally come across hundreds of results. This group has been in the news since 2008 for their on-going battle with University officials over the right to have GAP (Genocide Awareness displayed Project) their campus. Although CPL has been putting on these powerful demonstrations since 2006 without incident, the University has repeatedly

threatened them with arrest, expulsion and censorship. Finally earlier this year, the University went so far as to warrant individual, non-academic misconduct hearings for 8 members who proceeded with this demonstration in 2010. The University found the students "guilty" and issued each of them a formal written warning, stating that if they "fail to comply with directives of Campus Security staff in the future" it will "result in more severe sanctions." Cristina Perri, CPL secretary responded, "We've been informed that there are a lot of possible punishments involved, ranging warnings to expulsion, but there's nothing they can do to us individually that compares to what hundreds of unborn children encounter each day in our country."

Interesting fact number three: Only one woman, U of C's Acting Associate Vice-Provost Meghan Houghton conducted the hearings, denied the students legal representation AND was the sole decision-maker in the "guilty" verdict.
