Alex Schadenberg - Director of Euthanasia Prevention Coalition is currently speaking all over North America. His experience and insights are most helpful in educating all Canadians of the need to fight against the legalization of Assisted Suicide and Euthanasia ; practices that are already being performed in Canada.
