## Youth Banquet



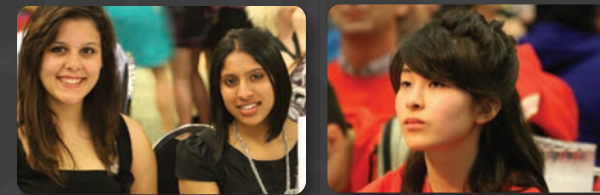
