**The Opportunity:** Applications are now being accepted for the Youth Coordinator position in Toronto, ON. The position will include intensive training and ongoing assistance and direction throughout the year from the staff and current Youth Coordinator at CLC.

The Youth coordinator will work with students and young professionals to spread the pro-life message on a national level but with a primary focus in Ontario.

### **Job Description**

**Purpose:** Recruit, activate, train, and educate young people (students and working professionals) across Canada for the pro-life movement and advance the goals of Campaign Life Coalition to effect political and social change.

**Importance:** Enables communication channels with present and future pro-life leaders and activists to ensure CLC's continued relevance through a professional and credible P.R. presence.

**Goals:** Recruit young people to grow volunteer base, supporter base, activists, and future employees in the pro-life movement.

### **Roles & Responsibilities**

- Public speaking engagements including school presentations (elementary, high school and post-secondary), youth group/church presentations, special events (i.e. conferences, rallies, and other public events)
- Manage, update, and maintain social media accounts on Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, YouTube, CLC website, and CLC youth blog
- Maintain CLC's public presence at events through appearances and networking
- Appearances on media representing CLC and/or CLC Youth
- Writing on life issues: blogging on behalf of CLC Youth

- Connecting youth inquiries with pro-life resources to further education and involvement
- Liaise with friendly organizations (i.e. other pro-life organizations) to achieve the goals of CLC
- Organize Youth side events at the March for Life including Candlelight Vigil, Youth Banquet, and Youth Conference

### **Skills Required**

- Ability to work independently and as part of a team;
- Excellent English communication skills;
- Comfortable with public speaking, and confident in speaking to a variety of audiences such as student groups, church gatherings, pro-life conferences and meetings etc.;
- Experience working with youth and young adult groups;
- Excellent interpersonal skills;
- Flexible and self-motivated;
- Strong organizational and time management skills;
- Ability to motivate and mentor students;
- Excellent computer skills and social media skills
- Ability to work evenings and weekends when required, and travel as necessary;
- Knowledge of pro-life issues, or the pro-life movement in Canada, and a firm dedication to supporting the cause;
- Having access to a car is an asset but not a requirement.

**Education Requirements:** An undergraduate degree or post-secondary diploma/certificate in a relevant subject area.
