Location: Campaign Life Coalition National Headquarters: 157 Catharine St. N., 2nd Floor Hamilton, ON, L8L 4S4*

Start/End Date: Negotiable; the program typically begins in late May for university/college students and in the beginning of July for high school students, and continues until the end of August

Hours: Monday- Friday, 9am-5pm (unless otherwise discussed); 37.5 paid hours/week

Wage: Minimum (\$15.50/hour)

Eligibility: 14-29 years old

*Preference will be given to those applicants capable of carrying out their assignments in-office. Our program is intended to instill a sense of camaraderie amongst interns, and certain activities like street activism can only be completed in-person. CLC would be happy to assist successful applicants in making travel arrangements and/or finding nearby accommodations. However, an applicant hoping to work remotely instead of in our office will still be considered for the position.

2023 SUMMER INTERNSHIP DESCRIPTION

All interns will be expected to work full-time, unless otherwise discussed. Interns will rotate through various assignments and supervisors every 1-3 weeks, so that they can appreciate the breadth of the work that we do - from administrative tasks, to research projects, to writing for *The Interim* Newspaper, to assisting our political team, to helping organize Life Chain and 40 Days for Life, to creating social media content and engaging peers through CLC Youth, etc.

In addition, each intern will be expected to participate in weekly training sessions to learn more about pro-life apologetics and the many facets of the pro-life movement. To put this knowledge into practice, interns will also be encouraged to engage in weekly activism, under the leadership of experienced activists.

Interns may have the privilege of attending various events, conferences, and webinars on behalf of Campaign Life Coalition, and meeting various pro-life leaders, from both within CLC, and outside of it—such as Silent No More Awareness Campaign's Angelina Steenstra, Euthanasia Prevention Coalition's Alex Schadenberg, etc. If you're not sure which arm of the pro-life movement you're most drawn to (educational, political, pastoral, spiritual), or you want a taste of it all, this internship is for you.
