Location: Campaign Life Coalition National Headquarters: 157 Catharine St. N., 2nd Floor Hamilton, ON, L8L 4S4*

Start/End Date: Negotiable; the program will begin on Monday, May 25th, 2026 for university/college students and on Monday, June 29th, 2026 for high school students, and ends on Friday, August 28th, 2026.

Hours: Monday- Friday, 9am-5pm (unless otherwise discussed); 37.5 paid hours/week

Wage: Minimum (\$17.60/hour for adults 18+, \$16.60/hour for students under 18)

Eligibility: 14-29 years old

*Preference will be given to those applicants capable of carrying out their assignments in our Hamilton or Ottawa offices. Otherwise, interns with a commute longer than 2 hours will be permitted to work remotely. Our program is intended to instill a sense of camaraderie amongst interns, and certain activities like street activism can only be completed in-person. CLC would be happy to assist successful applicants in making travel arrangements and/or finding nearby accommodations. Out-of-province applicants will be permitted to work remotely.

2026 SUMMER INTERNSHIP DESCRIPTION

All interns will be expected to work full-time, unless otherwise discussed. Interns will rotate through various assignments and supervisors every 1-3 weeks, so that they can appreciate the breadth of the work that we do - from administrative tasks, to research projects, to writing for *The Interim* Newspaper, to assisting our political team, to helping organize Life Chain and 40 Days for Life campaigns, to creating social media content and engaging peers through CLC Youth, etc.

In addition, each intern will be expected to participate in weekly training sessions to learn more about pro-life apologetics and the many facets of the pro-life movement. To put this knowledge into practice, interns will also be encouraged to engage in weekly activism, under the leadership of experienced activists.

Interns may have the privilege of attending various events, conferences, and seminars on behalf of Campaign Life Coalition, and meeting various pro-life leaders, from both within CLC, and outside of it—such as Silent No More Awareness Campaign's Angelina Steenstra, Euthanasia Prevention Coalition's Alex Schadenberg, etc. If you're not sure which arm of the pro-life movement you're most drawn to (educational, political, pastoral, spiritual), or you want a taste of it all, this internship is for you.
