What must be Deleted or Changed in Kathleen Wynne's controversial sex ed curriculum

Keep a condom with you (Grade 7 lesson)

In a lesson on <u>page 196</u> of the Wynne/Levin curriculum, children were taught to keep a condom on their person if there's a chance "they will be having sex sometime soon".

This is an overly explicit suggestion to children which leaves the impression with kids that we adults expect they are now having sex.

For some students, it might even be felt as pressure to become sexually active. For others, this type of lesson will only arouse curiosity. It is a recipe for launching children into promiscuity.

This kind of suggestion must be excluded from any future sex ed curriculum developed by the Ford government.
