What must be Deleted or Changed in Kathleen Wynne's controversial sex ed curriculum

Sexual Pleasure (Grade 7 lesson)

In a Grade 7 sex ed lesson, on <u>page 199</u> of the Wynne/Levin sex curriculum, teachers could help 12-yr-olds to appreciate an "understanding of your own body, including what gives you pleasure".

There is a serious problem with encouraging adult teachers to help their 12 year old students to "understand what gives them pleasure". Sexual predators do exist in the teaching profession unfortunately, and this lesson is an opening we don't want to give to any pedophile or teacher who is attracted to children.

I implore you to keep this lesson out of the new sex ed curriculum.

Around grade 7 or 8, children can be taught the basics of reproductive biology and how babies come about as the result of sexual intercourse, ideally in a loving marriage. However, all these undertones from the Wynne curriculum of *sexual liberation* and of **empowering children to make their own sexual decisions** must be kept out of the new curriculum that Premier Ford has promised parents.
