- Currently serves as MPP for Lambton-Kent-Middlesex
- Has been heroic in his vocal opposition to Kathleen Wynne's explicit sex education curriculum. The curiculum, which was written under the direction of a man who has confessed to child pornography-related charges, plans to:
 - teach about anal and oral sex in Grade 7
 - actively encourage children to masturbate in Grade 6
 - teach Grade 3 children the theory of Gender Identity, which holds that being a boy or a girl is not necessarily related to your physical anatomy
 - get 6 year olds talking about genitalia in Grade 1
- The only MPP who has spoken out against the sex ed program

- Currently serves as federal MP for Barrie
- Has a perfect voting record in the House of Commons on life and family issues, including having supported Stephen Woodworth's Motion 312 and opposed the transsexual "Bathroom Bill" C-279.
