STATE YOUR POLICY RESOLUTION.

Add new section:

83. Employment Non-Discrimination

The Conservative Party supports legislation to protect the rights of Canadian workers who believe in the traditional definition of marriage from employment discrimination on the basis of their deeply held religious beliefs. These fundamental rights are affirmed in the Charter of Rights & Freedoms.

STATE YOUR RATIONALE.

 Christians are being fired from their jobs, or rejected as potential candidates, on the basis of their religious belief in traditional marriage. Documented cases exist of such unlawful employment discrimination having taken place in television broadcasting (e.g. Damian Goddard), real estate (e.g. Andrew Ciastek / ReMax), tourism, law, office administration and marriage commissioners.
Such discriminatory practices violate Section 15.1 (equality) and Section 6.2(b) of the Charter which states: "Every citizen of Canada and every person who has the status of a permanent resident of Canada has the right to pursue the gaining of a livelihood in any province".
